PRAIRIE PAWS POLICY

Our goal at Prairie Paws is to provide your pet with a safe and stress free environment.

All pets must be in good general health, and owners will provide proof of current Rabies, DHLPP and Bordatella vaccines. Records of your dog's vaccinations, breed type, weight and description, as well as your contact information will be kept on-site.

All pets must be free of fleas and ticks and on a scheduled flea prevention program. If fleas or ticks are discovered upon arrival at Prairie Paws, we will administer treatment at owner's expense. Our goal is to protect all the animals in our care from fleas and ticks.

Dogs must be at least five months of age and be spayed or neutered before receiving our services. Any exceptions will be at owner's risk and responsibility.

Prairie Paws will use all reasonable precautions against illness, injury, or escape of pet(s), but will not be held liable or responsible, in the absence of negligence, on account of the care, treatment, or safety of your pet. In the unlikely event your pet should become ill, or suffer an injury while in our care, the pet owner is financially responsible for any medical services provided. We will attempt to contact you or your designated veterinarian to discuss treatment options. If we are unable to contact the pet owner for direction Prairie Paws will contact Johnson Veterinary Clinic to initiate proper treatment or prescribe needed medications.

While we make every effort to protect all pets in our care by limiting the number of pets we board at one time and assuring the utmost vigilance, we cannot guarantee your dog will never experience an accident or injury.

Prairie Paws encourages pet owners to bring their own bedding and a special toy to make their pets stay as stress free as possible. However Prairie Paws is not responsible for any blankets, beds, toys, leashes, or other personal items.

Should pet(s) remain unclaimed after the pick-up date, Prairie Paws will make every effort to contact the owner. Written notice will be mailed to the address on file with Prairie Paws. Seven days after the written notice, the pet(s) will be considered abandoned and may be taken care of as Prairie Paws deems best. It is further understood that such action will not relieve the pet(s) owner from paying all costs of services.
